Library/HUB – meeting the challenges of the information age

The library, sometimes called the HUB, is the TAFE students' one-stop shop for the information and support they need to study with TAFE. Library services are keen to keep pace with the changes in delivery and the education agenda and in technological advances, and play an essential role in supporting students and staff. In the last few years we have moved to the hybrid library model (book collections and digital collections), with access to all kinds of electronic and print resources, and a range of technologies to support lifelong learning.

Library services include loan of books, DVDs and magazines. Students can access a variety of online databases, including books and journals (magazines) and educational videos. We provide desktops and laptops, which all have Microsoft software, and are connected to the internet; we have wireless internet so that you can use your own device. There are number of iPads for student use, as well as access to photocopying and printing, scanning and laminating. A highly efficient, free inter-library loan service operates between all TAFE libraries, so we haven't got a resource you need, we can borrow it from another NSW TAFE library. Professional librarians provide reference and information services for students and staff throughout the year. Group and individual instruction is provided on the use of databases and subject-related resources, and in information literacy skills. The librarians can assist with computers and the internet, assignments and referencing as well as advice on resumes and job applications. They promote group work and study sessions, and a place to study, to help students complete their courses.

All students and the general public are welcome at the library – call in for a cuppa or a snack and see what we have to offer. Eating and drinking are acceptable in designated areas, and we sell tea and coffee at a nominal rate. The library has a much-commented on ambience and is a friendly, gathering place for groups and individuals



These courses are all developed to provide necessary skillsets for people wishing to begin work in libraries, or develop essential skills for recognition as a Library Technician. It is desirable that you are either comfortable using your local library resources or are currently working in the industry.
